Key features

- Approximately 630,000 bibliographic records and 140,000 review references are searchable (November 2019)
- More than 20,000 new records every year
- Over **1000 journals** systematically checked
- Extensive search possibilities
- Ability to query the database from Bible Verses, the Tenets of Canon Law, or the Dead Sea Scrolls
- Ability to export records in several formats (Endnote, Word, Refworks, Zotero, etc.)
- Ability to create email alerts
- Compatible with OpenURL
- DOI links to articles

- Text fully searchable

- Enrichment with more than 2200 biographical notes on bishops, drawn from the reference work *Die Bischöfe des Heiligen Römischen Reiches*.
